PUBLIC HEARING – CDBG – MINUTES

On a motion made by Deputy Mayor Majer, seconded by Trustee Schneider, the public hearing was opened at 7:05 PM.

Ryan Loucks of Crawford & Associates explained the particulars of Pine Street Phase II CDBG Application. Drainage along the sidewalk to North Road is the first portion of the project. Reducing water on the roadways, along with the aprons and driveways is also. Trees will be utilized to "green up" the area, and are included in the requested funding of \$150,000.00.

Permeable soils, perforated piping and roadway paving are a portion of this project. Ryan Loucks covered the scope and size of the project. He explained what a bio-swale is, and how it will work with the Tivoli clay and soil. There will be sidewalks, no curbing.

Trustee Ezrati spoke how it is a walkable Village, and the continuation of Pine Street CDBG, and how she is hopeful all grant requirements with the Dutchess County will be fulfilled.


Jeanette Canaday asked about the south sidewalk and hemlock trees behind Murray's. She asked if these trees were going to stay or be removed. It appears the trees are heaving the sidewalks which run parallel from the bus stop.

It was proposed to do less; alternate to different piping or soil, or use a grass swale in order to save money. The bio-swale, its cost effectiveness, maintenance of the bio-swale, how it gets trimmed and parking were discussed.

Jeanette Canaday mentioned the area on Pine Street, "Looks Beautiful!"

On a motion made by Trustee Schneider, seconded by Trustee Ezrati, all in favor, the public hearing was closed at 7:17 PM.
