

**VILLAGE OF TIVOLI BOARD OF TRUSTEES
REGULAR BOARD MEETING MINUTES
January 17, 2018**

A meeting of the Village Board of Trustees was held on January 17, 2018 at the Historic Watts DePeyster Hall, Tivoli, NY. Mayor Griffith opened the regular meeting at 7:08 PM.

The Mayor asked all present at the meeting to stand for the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Clerk's report included:

- Sale of 274 trash tags
- Two payrolls were processed
- Deputy Clerk attended one Zoning Board of Appeals meeting

Upcoming events: Village Clerk's Office will be closed Monday, February 19, 2018 in observance of the President's Day holiday.

On a motion by Deputy Mayor Majer, seconded by Trustee Schneider, the minutes for the December 20 regular board meeting and January 10 workshop were approved, all in favor.

On a motion by Trustee Ezrati, and seconded by Trustee Murphy, the Treasurer's Report for Abstract #8 totaling \$68,182.38 was approved. Trustee Schneider moved that the bills be paid for the abstract as presented and Deputy Mayor Majer seconded the motion, all in favor.

Zoning Report

Trustee Ezrati presented the Zoning Report which was provided by John Fenton, Building Inspector, and Zoning Enforcement Officer; Building Permits, Inspections, and Violations were addressed.

Mayor Griffith summarized the agenda and opened the meeting for public comments on agenda items only. There were no public comments.

Mayor Griffith provided information regarding the resolution authorizing an amendment to an agreement for the water and sewer system evaluation in the Village of Tivoli.

Tom Crisci, Sr. spoke about the fire company and its' pursuit of grant money. The new officer's list has been provided, and the new officers will be sworn in.

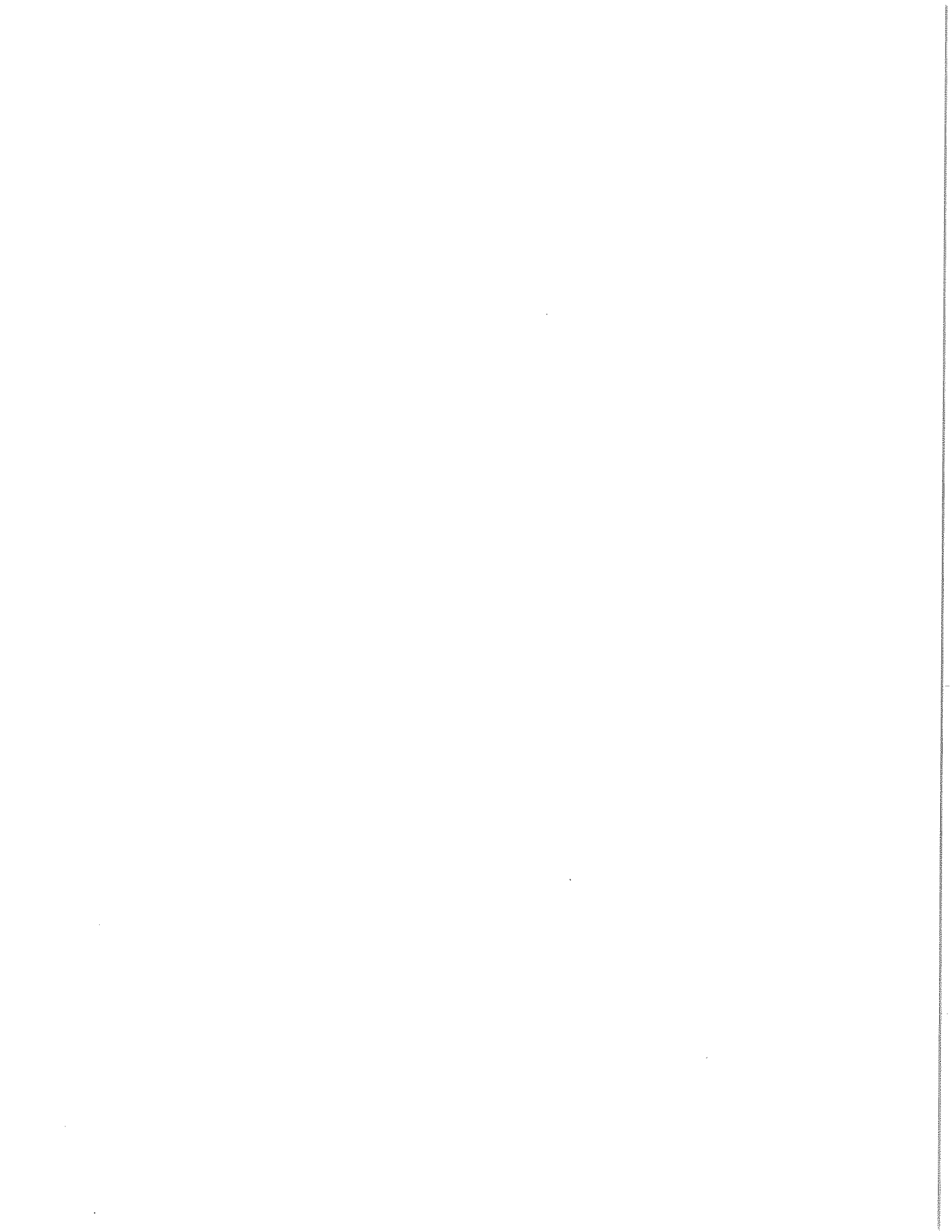
A Warming Center was made available for 6 hours on the extremely cold days for those who did not have heat.

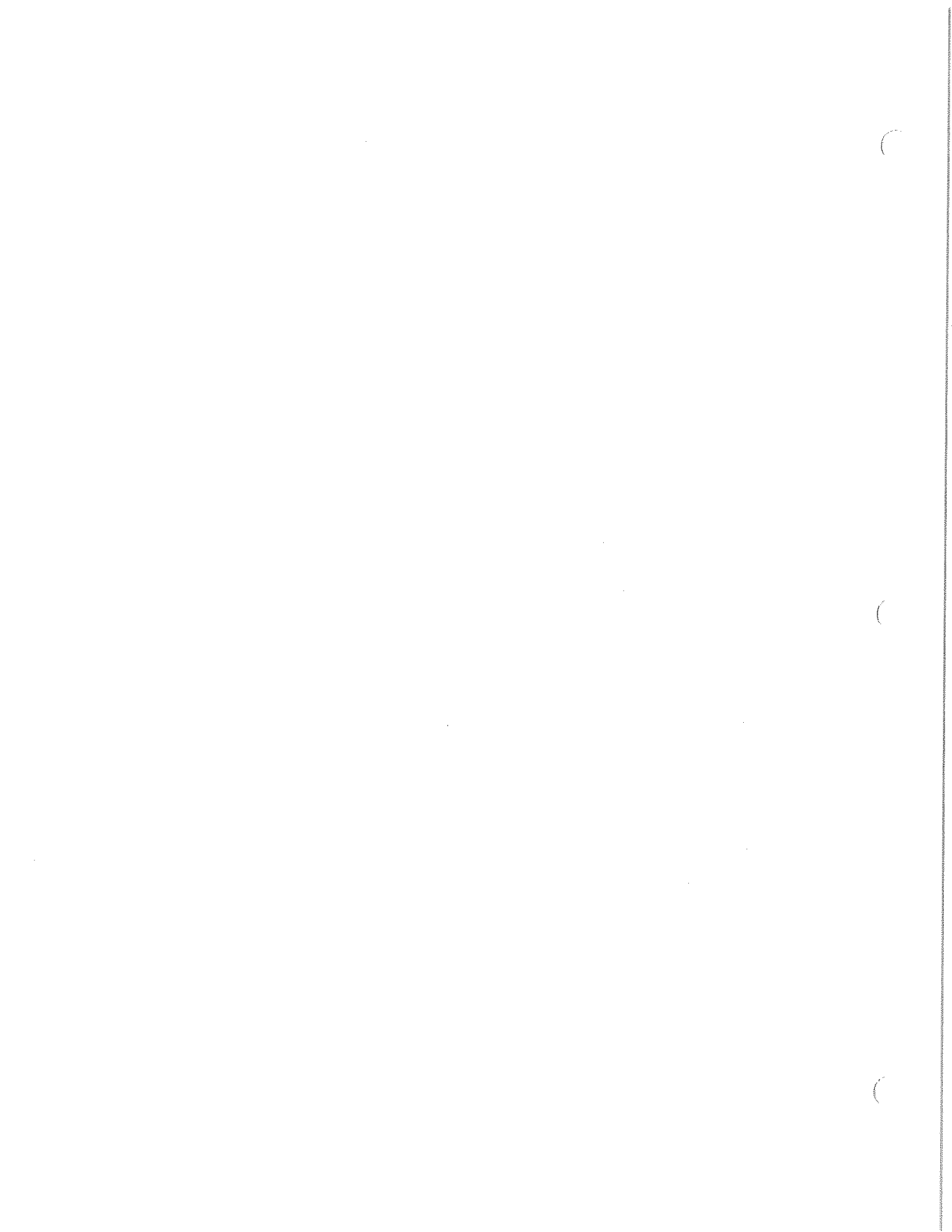
