

**VILLAGE OF TIVOLI BOARD OF TRUSTEES
PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES
LOCAL LAW; SOLID WASTE
January 17, 2018**

A public hearing regarding the local law on solid waste with the Village Board of Trustees was held on January 17, 2018 at the Historic Watts DePeyster Hall, Tivoli, NY. On a motion made by Trustee Ezrati, seconded by Trustee Schneider, the public hearing was opened at 7:03 PM.

Mayor Griffith reviewed the existing law, and also went over the changes in the new law.

Deputy Mayor Majer mentioned it would be nice to use the sidewalks without having to walk out into the streets.

Trustee Ezrati made note that there are multiple private haulers which come in to the Village. The Village Board is looking to create a system where continuity is apparent in the community.

Tom Crisci, Sr. mentioned it will be difficult to enforce the law where people have their trash cans out, but do not bring them in on time.

The law will require private haulers to register with the Village, and indicate which days they will be picking up. Even those residents with Village collection will be required to use a trash can and bring it in on time.

On a motion made by Trustee Murphy, and seconded by Trustee Schneider, all in favor; the public hearing was closed at 7:07 PM.
