

MEDIA ADVISORY

The State of Emergency declared by Village of Tivoli Mayor Bryan F. Cranna nearly two weeks ago following ice damage to the Village's water tower remains in effect as does the Executive Order Mayor Cranna issued to allow the DPW to purchase materials and or services without adhering to the Village's procurement policy.

Major icing occurred within the tower preventing water from entering or exiting the tower. Currently the Village is relying on wells for water supply. Residents may experience less water pressure than normal.

The Village's DPW continues to monitor the situation daily and some progress has been evident. The warmer temperatures are helping the situation.

Mayor Cranna stated, "I am grateful to the Village's DPW for their work on this issue. I ask that residents continue to be patient as we address this situation which we hope will be rectified in the coming days."
