

**VILLAGE OF TIVOLI BOARD OF TRUSTEES  
REGULAR BOARD MEETING MINUTES  
March 16, 2022**

A meeting of the Village Board of Trustees was held on March 16, 2022 at the Historic Watts DePeyster Hall, Tivoli, NY. Mayor Griffith opened the regular meeting at 7:06 PM.

On a motion by Trustee Ezrati, seconded by Trustee Baldino, the February 16 Regular Meeting Minutes were approved, all in favor.

On a motion by Deputy Mayor Majer and seconded by Trustee Mangieri, the Treasurer's Report for Abstract #10 totaling \$46,226.01 was approved. Trustee Ezrati moved that the bills be paid for the abstract as presented, Deputy Mayor Majer seconded the motion, all in favor.
